

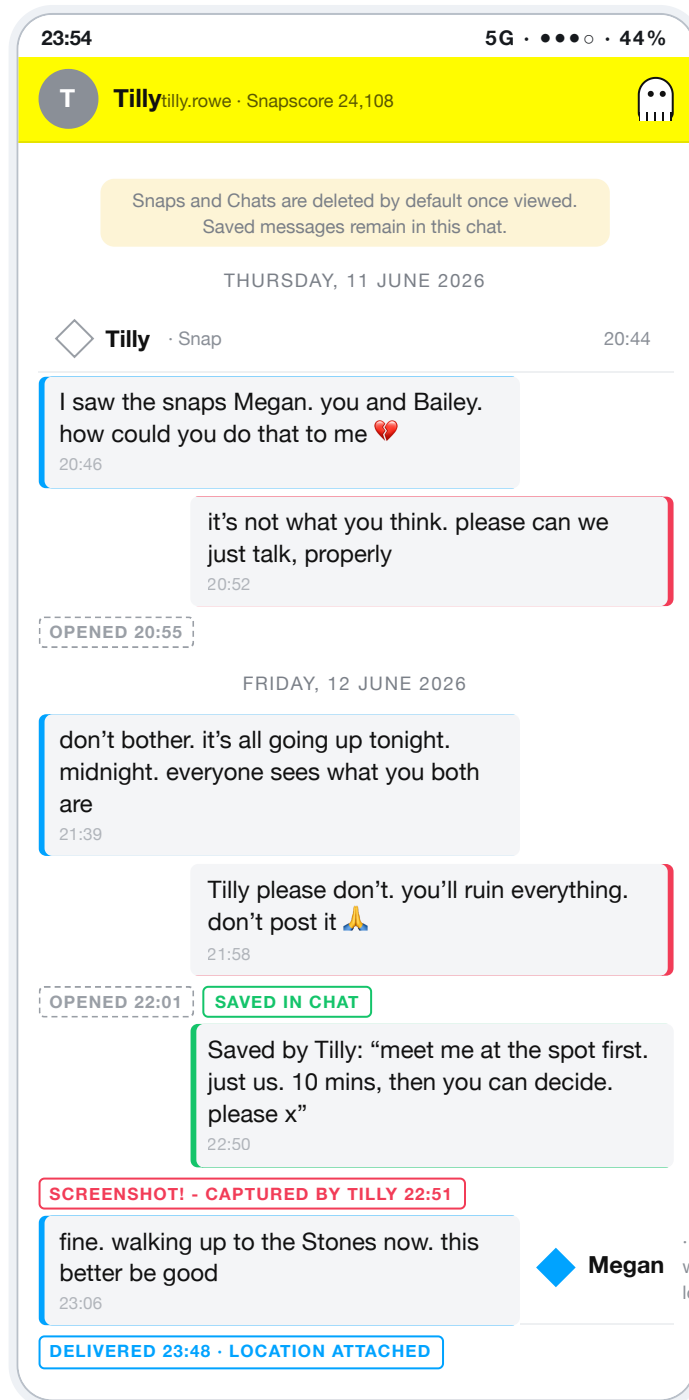

Reproduced content. Snapchat messages and snaps auto-delete by design, so most content is **ephemeral** and was not recoverable. Reproduced below are the items the provider held server-side at the time of the order: messages a party **Saved** in chat, snap **metadata** (sent/opened receipts, and any Snap Map location attached), and system **Screenshot** alerts. This is a forensic copy rendered to read as the app displayed it - **not** a live screenshot. The account holder (M. VOSPER (POI)) is the sending (red) party.

Reviewer's note - the "Snap with location" sent by megan.vosper at **23:48 on 12 Jun 2026** carries map metadata placing the account at **Stannon Field (the Stones), nr Tavistock** - the scene - within the pathologist's death window for the deceased. This contradicts the account holder's stated whereabouts (that she left the gathering about 22:30 and walked straight home) and is corroborated by the Snap Map location returns for 07700 900 142 (Exhibit OT/9). The lure message timed **22:50** survives only because M. ROWE (deceased) **Saved** it; the 22:51 **Screenshot** alert was raised by the provider when M. ROWE (deceased) captured that message. Ephemeral snaps between the saved items were not recoverable.
