999 CALL - VERBATIM EXCERPT

Transcribed from the recorded 999 line - opening 45 seconds. 'CH' = call handler CCO 6602 Pascoe; 'C' = caller.

CH: "Police emergency, what's the address of the emergency?"

C: "I'm up on the moor, the field off Drakewalls Lane, Stannon Field, just past the cattle grid. There's a young girl lying in the grass and she's not moving."

CH: "Stay on the line for me. Is she breathing, can you tell?"

C: "I don't think so. She's cold, love. My dog ran to her. I haven't touched her, I promise. Please, just send somebody quick."

CH: "Help is being arranged right now. Can I take your name?"

C: "Glenys Tremaine. I walk up here every morning. I'll stay with her." [caller remained on the line until units arrived]

07:52	CCO 6602 Pascoe	999 call connected from 07700 900 173. Caller (later confirmed Glenys TREMAINE) reports a young female lying motionless in a field, not breathing, at Stannon Field, off Drakewalls Lane, near Tavistock PL19 8NX. EISEC location plot SX 47120 73460. Incident DV-20260613-0091 opened, classified CONCERN FOR WELFARE.
07:53	CCO 6602 Pascoe	Caller states she is alone with the female and will remain at the locus. Graded Grade 1 (Emergency) on basis of unconscious/not-breathing female. Caller advised not to move the female and to keep clear of the immediate ground.
07:55	CCO 3318 Doidge	Resource assigned: response unit CHARLIE-BRAVO 21 (PC 2284 Veale) deployed from Tavistock. Rural locus, single track access via Drakewalls Lane; ETA 14 mins. Local supervisor notified on Channel 2.
07:57	CCO 3318 Doidge	Ambulance requested via SWASFT. SWASFT incident 260613-0418 raised; Cat 1 response. Devon Air Ambulance placed on standby for the moorland location.
08:09	CHARLIE-BRAVO 21	First officer on scene; directed in by caller from the field gate. Female located approximately 40m inside the field, no signs of life. SWASFT crew on scene 08:14.
08:22	CHARLIE-BRAVO 21	Life pronounced extinct by attending paramedic (recognition of life extinct, 08:22). Scene preserved; common approach path established along the field edge; scene log commenced by PC 2284 Veale. Caller detained as a witness.
08:36	Sgt 1140 Eddy	Incident RE-CLASSIFIED - CONCERN FOR WELFARE → Unexplained Death. Head injury noted; apparent staging of the body queried by first officer. Force Incident Manager (FIM) briefed; on-call DI informed.
08:55	Sgt 1140 Eddy	CID / Major Crime Investigation Team notified. On-call SIO contacted via FIM. CSI and Force Medical Examiner requested. Scene cordon (inner/outer) authorised across the field and lane approach.
09:20	Sgt 1140 Eddy	Incident handed to MCIT under Operation CURLEW. STORM log closed to control room; ongoing actions transferred to HOLMES. No further C&C resourcing required.
