Suspect interview under PACE 1984 - Bailey Northcott

*You do not have to say anything. But it may harm your defence if you do not mention when questioned something which you later rely on in court. Anything you do say may be given in evidence.*

The caution was read at 14:10. The interviewee confirmed he understood the caution and that he had been offered free and independent legal advice. The recording was conducted on approved digital media; the master recording was sealed in the presence of the interviewee and exhibited as RP/2.

### RECORD OF INTERVIEW

The following is a balanced record of the recorded interview. Passages in quotation marks are verbatim from the master recording RP/2; remaining passages are a fair summary. Tape counter (elapsed) shown for each turn.

00:00:40	DS PROWSE	Confirms those present (DS Prowse, DC Trevena, Mr Northcott, Mr Eddy of the duty solicitor scheme, and Mr S. Northcott as appropriate adult), the time and date, and that the interview is recorded. Confirms the caution is understood and that legal advice has been given.
00:02:30	DS PROWSE	"Tell me about Friday the 12th of June, the night Tilly died."

00:03:12	MR NORTHCOTT	"I was up the field earlier with everyone but I left before it got properly dark, about half nine, when Tilly's video kicked off. I didn't want to be there for it. I went home."
00:04:40	DS PROWSE	"Tilly's video said she would expose 'two people in the group'. Did you know who she meant?" MR NORTHCOTT, after a pause: "Yeah. Me and Megan. We'd been seeing each other behind Tilly's back. I'm not proud of it. Tilly found out."
00:06:15	DC TREVENA	"You commented on that video at half eleven, 'delete it before you regret it'. That reads like a threat." MR NORTHCOTT: "I was angry and I was scared everyone would find out. That's all it was. I'd never hurt her. I was at home on my phone the whole time, you can see I kept commenting."
00:08:05	DS PROWSE	"What time did you get home, and who was there?" MR NORTHCOTT: "About quarter to ten. My dad was in. We had a takeaway delivered about quarter past ten, it'll be on the account."
00:10:20	DC TREVENA	"Did you go back out to the field at any point that night?" MR NORTHCOTT: "No. I never went out again. I was messaging people online until about one in the morning."
00:12:35	DS PROWSE	"Did you and Megan speak that night?" MR NORTHCOTT: "She messaged me about eleven saying Tilly was kicking off and she was 'sorting it'. I told her to just leave it and go home. Then I went to sleep."
00:15:10	DS PROWSE	"Is there anything else you want to tell us?" MR NORTHCOTT: "Just that I didn't do anything to Tilly. I feel sick about all of it."

**Closing** - The interviewee was reminded of the caution throughout. He was informed that the master recording would be retained sealed and that he, or his legal representative, may obtain a copy on request. The interview concluded at **14:42**; total recorded duration **32 minutes**.

**Corroboration note for case papers:** The interviewee's account that he was at home from about 21:45 is consistent with continuous activity on his TikTok account across the evening (Exhibit OT/6, comments timed 23:31 and 00:09), a food-delivery record timed 22:14 on the household account, and his father's account. He admits a relationship with Megan Vosper and explains his hostile comment as anger. No evidence places him at the scene; he is treated as eliminated from the offence, subject to continuing enquiry.
